

The Lamb Traceability Pilot Project will yield many benefits for Canadian sheep producers – it has started already.

In a series of negotiations with both Shearwell and Canadian Co-operative Woolgrowers, the Alberta traceability pilot project team brought about a reduction of \$0.20 per tag for Shearwell's RFID tags. For the number of tags purchased in 2009, that would represent savings of \$107,633 for the Canadian sheep industry.

Effective January 1, 2010, the cost of the Shearwell EID tag is reduced to \$1.80.
